#### FROM THE PRINCIPAL

#### Collaboration Plan for Stage Teachers

Each Stage will have a Collaborative Planning Day this week. These days enable staff to create and share programs and units in each key learning area to ensure consistency between classes in terms of assessment, content covered and resourcing.

#### ANZAC DAY School Assembly

As ANZAC Day falls on Sunday this year, Erko will be having our traditional ANZAC assembly on Friday 23rd from 2.00-2.15pm. Thank you Eucalypt for preparing and running this special assembly.

#### NAPLAN

This year we will be completing most of the NAPLAN tests for Years 3 & 5 online. This will be a first for us so we are unsure of what all the logistical challenges may be. The testing period itself is longer to cater for some of the issues that have been identified by the department and may have a possible impact on it's running. Staff have ( and continue) to be given professional development around the processes and protocols of this new regime. I encourage you to gather more information from the NAPLAN website . #### **Reading Groups**

We have organised Zoom sessions and the link has been sent out via Enews. The form of the session will be twofold: to look at the administrative aspects/compliance and what specifically is expected from parents helping out. As this is the first time we have attempted to do something like this, the effectiveness of the program will be reviewed in Week 10. For this initial session we put no limitations on groupings or the number of helpers.

#### **PACER REBATE** (Parliament and Civics Education Rebate)

Students from our school have recently undertaken an education tour of the national capital. Students were given the opportunity to participate in a variety of educational programs with a focus on Australia's history, culture, heritage and democracy.

The Australian Government recognises the importance of all young Australians being able to visit the national capital as part of their Civics and Citizenship education. To assist families in meeting the cost of the excursion the Australian Government is contributing funding of \$30 per student under the Parliament and Civics Education Rebate program towards those costs. The rebate is paid directly to the school upon completion of the excursion.
